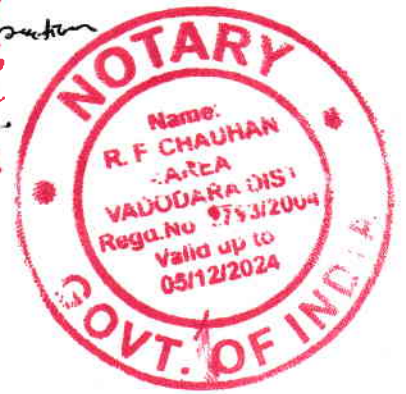

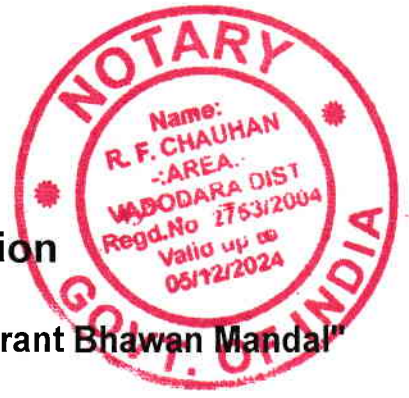

Scope : The entire country of Indian will be with the state of Gujarat.

OBJECTIVES OF PUBLIC TURST : To undertake activities for the public welfare and the happiness, peace and advancement of individuals and rural development without discrimination of caste, caste religion, language or province in the interest of the public like.

(1) Educational :-

To establish and maintain primary and higher schools, colleges, universities, colleges, libraries and other institutions connected there with for educational purposes and to support such activities and impart and disseminate mental, Cultural, Self-employment, medical, computer, scientific, agricultural education. [1] Membership:-

Any adult person taking an active interst in the objects of the organization may apply for membership by paying the prescribed fee and accepting the rules and regulations of the organization. But the Managing committee shall have the power to accept or reject any such application without assigning any reason. And there will be no need to give any reason for it.

A. Three- year membership can become a three-year member by depositing a membership fee of Rs.1000/- in the institution.
B-Annual Member : One can become an annual member by depositing the membership free of Rs.100/- in the Organization. The Management Commitlee my increase or decrease the membership fee From time to time by passing a resoluation by majority vote.

(2) Administrative Committee :-

A Committee of Management has been appointed at the First General Meeting to carry out the Objects of the Trust. The Number of Managing Trustees shall be not less than seven and not more than forty, the term of this Committee shall be tree years. The General Meeting shall appoint the Trustees From the Management Committee every three years. Out of which vacancy occurs due to any reason like death or resignation or additional as per maximum number limit.



in the event of appointment of trustees, the remaining trustees shall, by passing a majority resolution, appoint a suitable person from among the managing committee for the remainder of such vacancy or vacancy. He shall appoint office-bearers such as President, Minister, Joint Minister and Treasurer from among themselves by resolution.

(3) Office Bearers :-

This President : 1 President will hold the position of Chairman of the meeting of the Management Committee and the General Assembly, The Minister will implement the resolution taken in the meeting in a timely manner. will sign financial transaction and important documentsn.

2. The Agenda of all meeting shall be signed by the President.

b. vice President : will assist the President in his duties and their functions in his absense will do.

K.Minister : 1. The managing committee will keep all the minutes of the general meeting. 2. performs all operation related to the administration of the Trust as directed by the President. Dr. Joint Minister : - Will work according to the instructions and administration of the Minister. He Shall assist the Minister in his work and shall be a member and shall perform the duties assigned by the President.

(4) General Assembly and its scope :-

A general meeting of all the registered members of the organization will be called. Notice/Agenda for convening the meeting shall be given all the members of the Trust two days in advance and the meeting shall be held accordingly. 1/3 of the meeting will be. To ratify the annual report to approve including the total of income and expenditure, the work of formulating the auditor or making necessary changes or cancellation and the work of appointing the management after the expiry of the term shall be the work of the general meeting.



(5) Financial transactions :-

Joint information of the President and the Minister or any of the Member of the Managing Committee or the joint signatures of the Trustees as per the resolution of the Managing Committee The trust has to be transacted. and the bank account of the trust has to be operated. or the Management Committee may from time to time determine by resolution.

(6) Accounts :-

Accounts of the Trustee shall be kept as per the rules and shall be audited as per the rules after being approved in the meeting of the Managing Committee every year and shall be submitted to the office of the Charity Commissioner.

(7) Accounting Year :-

The Accounting year of the trust starts from 1st April and ends on 31st March.

(8) Instruments of income :-

The means of income will include membership fees, donations, Gifts, interest, fund-contribution, government and semi-government grants, aid, foreign aid, aid activity income etc.

(9) Sub- rules :-

Subject to the provisions of this Constitution and the provisions of the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950, the Trust May, by resolution of the Managing Committee, Make bye-laws and modify or repeal such rules.

(10) Return Committee :

The Management Committee may constitute a sub-committee in cases where it is deemed necessary for the purpose of the trust, but the member of the committee shall not be considered a trustee.

(11) Management Committee Meeting :-

The Managing Committee meeting shall be convened at least once every six months and all the Managing Committee Members shall be notified at least three day in advance. The Managing



Committee shall supervise the meetings of the Management Committee to prepare the budget of the organization to prepare the income and expenditure accounts, to get the accounts audited and submitted to the charity commissioner's office on time

(12) Minute Book :-

The Minister shall record all the proceedings of the Management Committee and the General Meeting in the Minute Book as per the instruction of the President.

(13) Trust Properties :-

The immovable property, movable properties of the trust and any new properties acquired from the institution thereafter shall be deemed to be the properties of the institution. On second mortgage or loan (without collateral) can be obtained.

(14) Matter of acquisition of properties of the organization :-

The properties of the institute as it continues shall be vested in the Management Committee in the name of the institute and the Management Committee of all such properties shall be subject to this Memorandum and Articles of Association.

(15) Power to appoint employee :-

The Management Committee may appoint employees for the purposes of the purposeful work of Committee and the payment of such employees' wages and salaries shall be subject to their terms of appointment and in the interest of the organization the Board of Trustees may dismiss such employees and may change the term of appointment of the employees.

(16) Regarding modification of this Memorandum of Association :-

When it appears to be necessary to alter or amend the document, such amendment may be added or amended by a written resolution of a majority of the trustees at that time. Who can make such change subject to the law of that time.

(17) Matter of dissolution of organization :-

if this organization is not in a condition to be run, if it is in a condition to be closed in the future, all transaction and accounts shall be



handed over to and organization having the same Purpose and all the assets as per the rules, immovable or movable properites cannot be divided internally. All the above operations will be don subject to the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 which is the law of that time.
